## A STAR WITHIN A CIRCLE

(The feature of the program is centered around the Star Points. Each should have flowers, or a small gift wrapped in each of the 5 colors, to be presented to the WM at the close of each Point's speech. A star is formed by the Points standing at a position with ribbons extended from each to each so that a star is outlined. Those forming the star rotate as their names are called, making the star move from point to point, clockwise. When the Marshal whirls the star, she calls the name of the

MASTER OF CEREMONIES: WM, in order to further attest our love and appreciation for you and to bestow on you every honor to which you are entitled as our leader, we wish to present a tribute, using as our central figure the 5 points of the Star. It shows a Star within a Circle. It has a double meaning which we will work out before your very eyes tonight.

(Star Points move to take their places.)

MARSHAL: Life is a Circle. We some upon the stage. We stand for a brief moment and deliver our message, then we swing around the circle and are gone. She has brought light into our Chapter room. Her knowledge of our work has added to its beauty and meaning. The Sword and Veil have meant to her a courage to defend the right and a sympathy for our frailties that made her draw the veil of kindness over all of our mistakes. I hence her tonight with the colors of my station. And, with these flowers I offer her my sincere friendship. (Presents flowers.)

MARSHAL: Again I turn the Circle and the star shows its colors. Like a living thing, it glows with a yellow ray. (Stops star with Yellow point at top.)

MARSHAL: Again the star whirls and the circle is ecaplete. (Stops star with White Point at top.) Esther stands before us. Sister Eather, have you a word of praise for our WM? ESTHER: PURITY and JOY are part of the character of our WM. While she has wern the exoun of authority all year and has held the scepter of administration in her hand, she has never used her authority unduly or her scepter unjustly. Her unselfish loyalty to her members and to her Chapter is a token that she has been worthy of the high position to which we called her. In the name of our beloved Eastern Star, I present this token of our admiration and appreciation. (Presents flowers.)

MARSHAL: Another Star Point comes into view. (Stops star with Green point at top.) Sister Marths, what message do you bring?

MARTHA: HOPE and IMMERTALITY are 2 of the virtues our WH has exemplified in her work in our Chapter room. She has offered comfort to the broken hearted and has pointed the way to a higher, nobler service for us all to follow. Her falth, her efforts to teach by example the thing she believes has made us all more faithful and loyal to each other. My gift of love bears the colors of my station. (Presents flowers.)

MARSHAL: The last Star Point completes the circle. (Steps star with Red Point at top.)

ELECTA: Our beloved WM has been filled with a FERVENCY for our Chapter that will long be remembered. Her service has been outstanding. She has brought blessings rich and abounding to the meaning of our ritual. In her has sincere hospitality been reflected. The stranger has been welcomed. The honored guest has been given every added honor. The cup of friendship has overflowed with gladness; and the joy of comradeship has been given new life. To our WM, who has so beautifully exemplified in her delly life the teachings of our Order, I present this token of our love. (Presents flowers.)

MARSHAL: A Star within a Cipele. Our Master of Geremonies said we would watch it unfold before our very eyes. Star Points, you will bring this to pass. Attend to it now.

(Ster Points encircle WM, making a circle with hands clasped.)

(A solo, chorus, or group singing of some appropriate Song.)

MASTER OF GEREMONIES: A Ster within a Circle. Our WM is our Ster tonight. The

Circle of Love is around her. (Here Ster Points open circle.) Let us all stend and

join hands and thus extend the Circle of our Love so that it will held us all within

the bonds of friendship as long as we all may live - and beyond our earthly habitation.

(All members form circle.)

CHAPLAIN: Our Father, as children drawn close to Thee because of the ties of Love which bind us all together and to Thee, we ask Thy blessing on our guest of honor here tonight. We ask that Thy protecting care may shield her from all serrow. May Thy choicest blessing for her be peace and joy and gladness; and may her life continue to send its radiance down through the years as a blessing to those she labors with. And keep us, Thy children, free from the vanities of the world so that we may labor for Thee and show Thy love to thus a world seeking a sign from Heaven. We give Thee thanks for this association of friends who love and serve each other. Be with us all until we meet again.
