Outgoing ceremony

Worthy Matron says "the officers will now perform the outgoing ceremony" The Marshal stands and the rest of the officers all stand at the same time. When the W.M and W.P. start down the steps all officers move to the Altar similar to the way we do the prayer circle. See the diagram.

When all are in place, join hands on a signal from the marshal, raise your hands shoulder high.

The W.M. starts and says "Some must lead while others follow" then she lowers her left hand and W.P.'s right.

W.P. says "Be strong and compassionate" and lowers his left hand and Adah's right. As soon as both hands are free assume the sign of reverence.

Adah: Be faithful to your moral obligation.

Sec. : Record your memories. Mar. : Be orderly in your life.

Cond.: Constant and steady reaps perfection. Ruth: To have plenty prepare little by little.

Sent. : Protect the things you value.

Ward. : Always be on guard.

A.M.: Learn to guide.

Esth. : An upright life brings purity.

A.P. : Be ready and willing to give assistance.

Mart.: A trustful life brings hope. .

A.C. : Discipline your desires.

Treas.: Give to love and love to give.

Chap.: Know and obey the word of God.

Elec.: Love each other as you love yourself.

All sing God be with you till we meet again .

Bible is carried out

On a signal from the Marshal all turn toward the door.

Starting on their left foot, the Sentinel and Warder will lead the outgoing march straight out the door, followed by Ruth and A.M. Cond. and Esther and so on. Give your badge to the Sentinel at the door.
