Lights are lowered.

The Star points, Conductress, Associate Conductress, Secretary, Marshal, Treasurer, and Chaplain form semicircle around Altar, each with lighted candle. The Associate Matron and Associate Patron approach the East by passing on south and north of laby-rinth, respectively. They bow to retiring Matron and Patron, and escort them to position between Altar and dais facing west, with Matron and Patron standing between Associate Matron and Patron, When in position, Jewels are presented as follows:

For presenting Jewel to retiring Matron:

It is my happy privilege at this time to bring you a few words of grate-ful appreciation from the members of this Chapter. Our associations together through the years have been happy ones, and the fellowship which we have enjoyed has added beauty to the Order we love. You have served our Order well. The task has been yours to tend for awhile, and soon the sacred flame which you have kept burning will be replenished by other hands, and through your efforts they will catch a better vision of that beautiful Star in the East.

Happiness is but the echo of some service which we have previously sent out. May the kindness and consideration which you have shown the past year as Worthy Matron reflect a great joy in your life that will last for years to come. We have shared with you in delightful fellowship, and as the days come and go, may you often look back to the untold pleasures which have made this year one of the happiest of your life. As a reminder of our gratitude, we present to you this gift. Not to repay you for your service, for it could not be done; but to remind you of the love you have given, and the love we have tried to give in return.)

At close of song, Associate Matron and Associate Patron escort retiring Matron and Patron around inside of semicircle, the Associate Patron and retiring Matron going to right, and the Associate Matron and retiring Patron going to left. Associate Matron and Patron extinguish candles of officers in passing. Esther's candle is left burning. As retiring officers meet in front of her station, Esther speaks as follows:

There remains one light in the Heavens To light your way each day.
The Star that shone over the manger Still shines for you on your way;
This Star of the East will lead you The rest of your journey through,
It will daily lead you onward,
And keep you ever true.

For your task is not yet finished,
Your work is not yet done,
You must keep right on in the service
'Till the race of life is run;
Your reward will be much greater,
If you're faithful in the least,
And our Star will shine forever
As it leads you from the East.
