As the Flag is returned, let us stand at salute in tribute to the emblem of the Nation that guarantees to its citizens the rights of free assembly, free speech, free worship and the rights of free men and women and Eastern Star Members. Brother AP (or Marshal) return the flag.

And the one that my husband (when WP & as a request of myself at my Honor Nights) does AFTER Chapter is closed and the flag has been returned ...
