

## GENERAL GRAND CHAPTER ORDER OF THE EASTERN STAR

ESTABLISHED NOVEMBER 1876

WASHINGTON, D. C., May 15th, 1936.

## DEAR MEMBERS OF THE EASTERN STAR:

Only a short time before the death of Brother John Hammill he called at the office of the Right Worthy Grand Secretary and in conversation concerning the New Eastern Star Temple and the raising of funds for its maintenance, suggested that a letter containing the comparative amounts contributed by the Grand Chapters together with a statement of the number of members in each Grand Jurisdiction and the amount contributed by each would make it plain as to the 100% status of the Grand Chapters. Such a statement has been prepared and is being forwarded with this to Grand Officers, Past Grand Officers and Temple Committees for their information.

We find that only a few members know that the General Grand Chapter receives no money from any Grand Chapter for its maintenance and we now present several reasons why we believe members of the Eastern Star should be glad to cooperate for the Temple.

- 1.—The General Grand Chapter was organized in 1876, sixty years ago.
- 2.—It has never received one cent from any Grand Chapter for its expenses.
- 3.—The General Grand Chapter pays the expenses of the Officers and Committee Members to the Triennial Assemblies.
- 4.—This is the first time in its history that it has ever promoted a plan that called for contributions of money from members or from Grand Chapters.
- 5.—The General Grand Chapter believes that there are but few members who have not derived some pleasure from membership in the Eastern Star.
- 6.—The General Grand Chapter with two million members, consisting of the most worth-while people in the country, believes it is worthy of a permanent home.
  - 7.—The General Grand Chapter believes the Eastern Star has justified its existence and should be perpetuated.
- 8.—The General Grand Chapter believes that if the Eastern Star has meant anything to a member and given any pleasure or benefit, the member will be willing to cooperate at this time for the permanent maintenance of the new Temple.
- 9.—Other organizations have Temples which raise their roofs to the sky and we believe the Star in the East should shine down on one exclusively belonging to the Eastern Star.
- 10.—This is the time to show to all the world that we are a harmonious progressive organization, serving our fellow man by cooperating in the Temple Plan.

11.—The Temple is ours. It is paid for. It will soon be in readiness for occupancy. It is outstanding in architecture and beauty.

12.—This Temple Plan asking your assistance is not a demand; it is not an assessment; it is an opportunity to show your loyalty to the Order.
