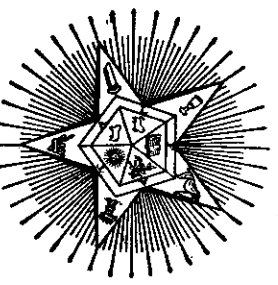

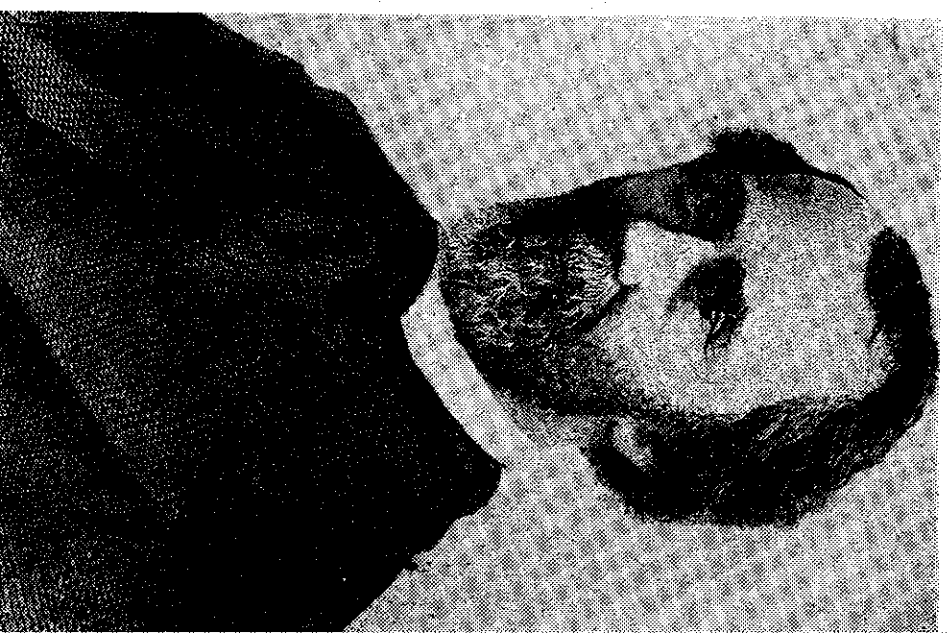

the grand chapter in the early days of its existence, this fund has been maintained wholly by voluntary contributions from chapters, individuals, associations auxiliary to the order, and by Eastern Star clubs.

The order maintains an Eastern Star home at Orange, Mass., which was dedicated Oct. 12, 1925, "to charity, truth, and loving-kindness." Mrs. Carrie A. Cushing, a past grand matron and later grand secretary for many years, made the recommendation to establish the home in 1901.

After years of fund-raising, the Wheeler mansion in Orange was purchased, along with the abutting Howe estate to allow for possible expansion. Many individual chapters and organizations furnished rooms at the home, where more than 120 members of the order have been given shelter and care.
