For presenting ribbons or flowers to Star points using Stars in color.

Stars covered with foil or metallics in appropriate colors are presented to each Star point. Ribbons in color or flowers may be given with the Stars.

Star points may gather around Altar to receive stars, or they may be presented as Marshal passes from one station to another.

Verses for Marshal:

This morning I went to the garden,
While the flowers were wet with the dew,
And they sparkled like stars in the sunshine,
So I gathered a few just for you.

The violets that grew in the corner,
Held stars of a heavenly blue,
And the jessamine with it's yellow flowers,
