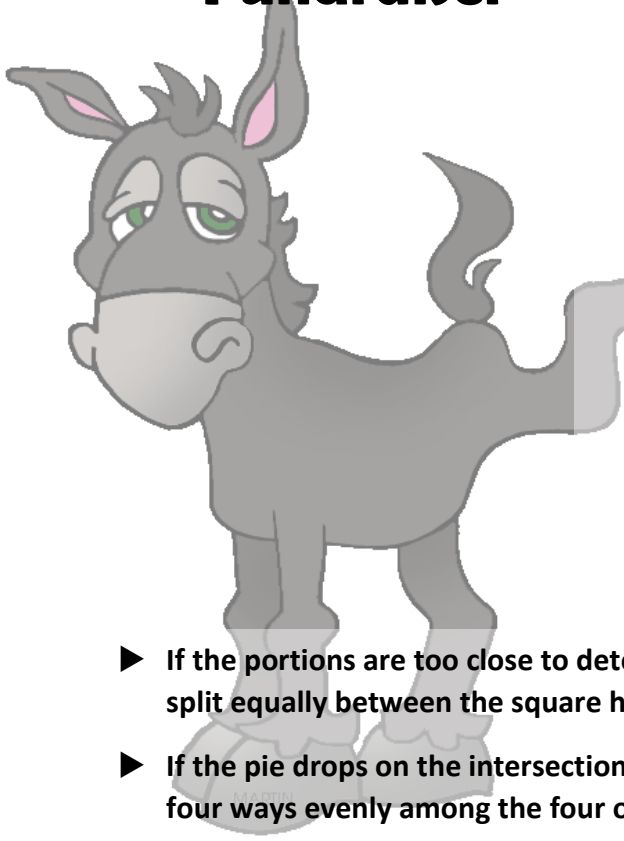




## Fountain Valley Chapter #155

Experience the “sweet smell of success.” Two mules will be turned loose on a fenced-in area which has been marked off into 100 squares. The mules determine the winner by making the first “deposit” on one of the squares. Chances on each square are sold for \$10. The winner receives 40% of the sales.

### Mule Manure Bingo Fundraiser



- ▶ Each square will be assigned a random number.
- ▶ Tickets will be available from any Fountain Valley Chapter member up until 1 o'clock PM on 15 January 2024 at the Past Matron and Past Patron lunch.
- ▶ There is no limit to the number of squares that can be purchased by an individual.
- ▶ Two mules will be released onto the pen and will freely roam.
- ▶ If the either mule happens to drop its FIRST manure pie into your square, YOU WIN!!
- ▶ Winner is based off either mule's FIRST plop within the numbered field.
- ▶ If the pie lands in more than one or more, the square that contains the largest portion of the pie will be declared the winner.

- ▶ If the portions are too close to determine a winner, the prize money will be split equally between the square holders.
- ▶ If the pie drops on the intersection of four squares, the cash prize will be split four ways evenly among the four owners.
- ▶ If the pie lands on a square that is unsold, the winner will be the closest “sold” square or squares immediately adjacent to and sharing at least one full side with the unsold square. This could end up being more than one winner (up to, but not to exceed, 4 winners) who would share in the prize money equally.
- ▶ Judges will be present during the event to determine the winner.
- ▶ Proceeds will be split between Fountain Valley benevolent projects and the Fisher House on behalf of the Worthy Grand Matron and Worthy Grand Patron.
